Shall the Board of Directors of the Anamosa Community School District in the counties of Jones and Linn, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, to levy annually, as determined by the Board, a voter-approved Physical Plant and Equipment property tax not to exceed sixty-seven cents (67) per one thousand dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy for collection commencing July 1, 2006, to be used for the purchase and improvement of grounds; the construction of schoolhouses or buildings and opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings; the payment of debts contracted for the erection or construction of schoolhouses or buildings, not including interest on bonds; the purchase of buildings and the purchase of equipment; procuring or acquisition of libraries; repairing, remodeling, reconstructing, improving, or expanding the schoolhouses or buildings and additions to existing schoolhouses; expenditures for energy conservation; the rental of facilities under Chapter 28E; purchase of transportation equipment for transporting students; lease purchase option agreements for school buildings; or equipment purchases authorized by law.
